Dear Applicant,

I am writing to advise you that effective August 10, 2020 NNAS will temporarily issue Advisory Reports that include language test scores that meet all requirements and are current for at least 6 months following the release date of the Advisory Report.

Applicants are responsible for ensuring that their language test results are no older than 18 months at the time their Advisory Report is issued. When possible NNAS recommends submitting language test results that are no older than 6 months at time of application. It is also recommended that applicants monitor the submission of other documents when scheduling language tests.

NNAS' current language requirements remain in place. Please refer to the NNAS Handbook to review NNAS' language requirement. Applicants are advised to check with the Regulatory Body or Bodies to which they are applying to find out about any policies related to language proficiency specific to the Regulatory Body or Bodies.

NNAS is aware that COVID-19 may cause delays for some applicants who are waiting for third-party verification of documents. In response, NNAS is modifying the process for submitting language test results. Decisions regarding registration or licensure remain the legislative responsibility of the Nursing Regulatory Bodies.
